In addition to his treatment plan, Shawn altered his diet to improve his health and increased his fitness level where he could participate in the ZERO Run/Walk as Captain of Team Super Shawn. He shared his story at this year's race so that more men know that it's not just an old man's disease and that early detection is vital.
