The Center for Advanced Manufacturing and Materials at Harrisburg University, better known as STORMWERX, has been awarded a portion of a \$1.2 million sustainability-focused project grant as part of the America Makes initiative and the EARTH (Environmental Additive Research for Tomorrow's Habitat) Project. HU is advancing EARTH's goals in three ways: Advance 3D printing by improving material testing and supporting printer-profile development, Print and develop parts selected by DEVCOM (US Army Combat Capabilities Development Command), and print parts for the US Army to test in military vehicles. STORMWERX is seeking reliable ways to recycle PET plastic for use in 3D printers. This would address longstanding challenges in exploration and construction, including printing habitats for Lunar bases and undersea habitats. Combining 3D printing with material reclamation could have far-reaching impacts: Reclaiming plastics for 3D printing could help meet material needs in communities while reducing plastic waste present in water bodies or landfills. PET is common in packaging for military-grade products. Ideally, military bases could capture plastic waste and responsibly reuse it using 3D printers. After natural disasters, it could be possible to rapidly manufacture housing components and other life-supporting products using resilient polymers already present in the region. Recapturing waste plastic to meet these needs will greatly reduce the footprints of the logistics, manufacturing, and transportation processes humans depend on to meet their material needs. This sustainability project award is the latest development in what has been a consequential and mutually beneficial relationship that directly supports various research and defense initiatives.
