**CAMP HILL, PA:** On Wednesday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, Central Penn College celebrated the grand opening of their new Surgical Technology Education Center (STEC) with a ribbon cutting! Among the new state-of-the-art features in the 4,335-square-foot Surgical Technology Education Center (STEC) are:

- a Virtual Reality classroom,
- an operating room (OR) simulation room with a double ceiling-mounted light,
- a scrub room with a double-bowl hospital-grade scrub sink,
- a storage area for the OR, one classroom lab and two classrooms,
- a kitchenette, conference room, student study area, two offices for instructors, and restrooms.

Many supporters helped to make the day possible, including a grant from UPMC Pinnacle Foundation and a \$1.4 million grant from the Cumberland County Commissioners also delivered much-needed support. To an audience that included more than 60 faculty members, board members, donors, students and staff, College President Linda Fedrizzi-Williams said, “Thank you for believing in higher education, thank you for believing in Central Penn College and thank you for supporting our students.”
