The program distributes gaming revenues through the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA) to support projects that serve the public interest across Pennsylvania. “CAEDC is proud to have assisted in securing funding for these impactful projects that will strengthen communities across Cumberland County,” said CAEDC Economic Development Director Greg Welker. “Helping our partners navigate the grant process and bring meaningful investments to fruition is central to our mission, and we’re pleased to see these projects move forward.” The next Local Share Account (LSA) application cycle opens July 1, and prospective applicants with qualifying projects may contact Alyssa Smith (Alyssa@CumberlandBusiness.com) at CAEDC for additional information and application support.
